

Materials List

- journal or notebook
- pencil, charcoal, whatever you like to draw with
- sketchbooks
- scalpel and scissors
- stick of glue
- acrylic paints : cadmium yellow, lemon yellow, cerulean blue, ultramarine blue cobalt blue, phthalo blue, alizarin crimson, cadmium red, magenta, white burnt umber, yellow ochre, paynes grey, burnt sienna, black other favourites. I like cobalt teal (Golden), vivid pink by Pebeo and buff titanium
- gesso (general for use on all surfaces)
- kitchen roll
- baking parchment/freezer paper
- trays for palettes or large wet palette
- thin paper that will take paint - eg wet strength tissue paper or Rhodia 80gsm
- card if you want to make paint swatches
- A1 cartridge paper - 300gsm
- watercolour paper that you like if you want to paint pieces on paper
- canvas, start small and scale up later
- wood panel/cradled board
- gelli plate
- masking tape
- wide selection of brushes
- palette knives and miscellaneous items to dip into paint
- brayer
- grouting tools - spatulas
- pastel ground by golden
- Frisket matt low tack masking film
- P120 sandpaper
- rags
- wood panels or boards to attach paper to
- gummed butterfly tape if you want to stretch watercolour paper
- medium /acrylic paint extender for glazing and thinning paint
- isolation coat - optional
- UV varnish in a finish you like
- old jars and ice cream containers with lids
