# **Art Supplies List**

**Year: Foundation/Prep/K**

## Year Foundation/Prep/K: Art Supplies List

The following art supplies are needed to complete this course (similar brands are perfectly okay.)

### Term – 1: Recommended Art Supplies

#### For all lessons:

- 1 HB graphite pencil, Eraser and Pencil sharpener
- Pack of inexpensive coloured pencils, or marker pens.
- 1 clear plastic sleeve **(for printed image from the course lesson 6)**
- Playdough and 1 pop stick per child **(For lesson 6)**

### Term – 2: Recommended Art Supplies

#### Lesson: 1

- 1 HB graphite pencil, eraser and sharpener
- Pack of inexpensive coloured pencils

#### Lessons: 2 to 8

- 2 sheets white A4 card or watercolour paper for exercises Dennis and Billie
- Blue and green paper to be torn for collage (optional lesson 3)
- Wax-based crayons (preferably Crayola Brand Turn and Colour)
- Watercolour Pan style – just 3 primaries plus black and white (Red, Blue, Yellow)
- Medium round taklon paint brush
- Plastic placemats or spare paper to protect tables from spillage.
- Small plastic takeaway container or cup with a wide base for water
- Paper towel for cleaning up any messes.

## **Term – 3: Recommended Art Supplies**

### **Lessons 1 to 3:**

- 1 HB graphite pencil, eraser and sharpener
- Pack of inexpensive coloured pencils and marker pens

### **Lesson 4:**

- A portion of approximately 225 grams each of air- hardening clay
- Small plastic side plate (as a mould for the clay to go on the inside)
- Small plastic container or cup with a wide base for water to dip into with fingers

### **Lesson 5:**

- Paper towel for cleaning up any messes with acrylic paint.
- Small piece of sandpaper (optional – to smooth down any uneven areas before painting.)
- Light coloured Acrylic paints such as orange, red, yellow, pale blue (to paint the full colour undercoat front and back of their clay plates. Next lesson they will paint the details) – a variety of colours for your students to choose from. They should choose only one colour.
- 1 large flat hog hair (for painting their plate)

### **Lesson 6 –**

- Black coloured pencils (to draw onto their clay plate) later they will paint over their design in the matching paint colour.

### **Lessons 7 and 8 –**

- Small round Taklon 0 size brush (for fine lines and details)
- Black acrylic paint in a plastic plate (in the centre of the table for a group)
- Pots with water for washing brushes
- Cotton buds (to dampen and tidy up messy strokes (used carefully so as not to lift the first layer of paint off the plate.)
- Paper towel for keeping areas clean and for wiping brushes onto.

## Term – 4: Recommended Art Supplies

### Lesson 1:

- Student printouts (construction drawing animals)
- Graphite pencil for drawing
- Black marker pen or pencil for outlining (before colouring in next lesson)

### Lesson 2:

- Black pencil or a black marker pen (to outline)
- Crayons (preferably Crayola brand,

### Lesson 3:

- large sheet of **black card** (A3 size) and plain white scrap paper to practice
- Watercolour paints (white and blue for splattering stars)
- Tissues and cotton buds (to clean up accidental big blobs in the stars)
- Medium size hoghair brush (for splattering stars)
- Small pot of water for washing brushes
- Art smock to protect clothing
- 1 HB graphite pencil, eraser and sharpener
- Student printout images (crazy robot heads)
- Plastic or other protective cover for tables

### Lesson 4 onwards:

- 1 HB pencil, eraser and sharpener

### Lesson 5 onwards:

- **Black coloured pencil** (for outlines on white paper)
- Pack of crayons (preferably Crayola brand)
- Scissors
- Wool or string (for robot legs and arms)
- Glue (preferably Elmers School Glue)
- 1 Plastic sleeve with student name (to store cut-out images)
